Fourth Week in Ordinary Time

Most weeks, when I start this column, I bring up many of my favorite spiritual writers to see what they have to say about that week's readings. But this week, when praying about the Beatitudes, one name surfaced loudly and clearly: Father Greg Boyle, SJ, founder of Homeboy Industries, the world's largest gang intervention and rehabilitation program, (and yes, there is now Homegirl Industries, too.)

Greg Boyle understands those who are poor, and weak, and grieving. He employs hundreds of them, some right out of prison, in his bakeries and restaurants in Los Angeles. He also understands, intimately, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness. He's at the top of that list.

His teaching on the Beatitudes is simple. It's just geography. It's not about WHAT to be, but WHERE to be, which is always with the vulnerable. True blessing isn't health or wealth, but finding life and joy in solidarity with those the world rejects, even if it leads to crucifixion, since that's where Jesus is. So, a re-write of the Beatitudes might be, "You know you're in the right place if...you are singlehearted, working for justice, showing mercy, working for peace."

But how do we who have never been materially poor crowd in with, as Richard Rohr writes, the poor in spirit, whose "material poverty has broken their spirit"? My only answer is to hang out with people who serve those who are poor with abundant love. Christ, who will always side with the poor, begs us to place ourselves in proximity to "the weak of the world," so that we too may learn from them. Theirs is the kingdom.

Have you ever been inspired by someone who is "humble & lowly"?

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Cuarto Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

Casi todas las semanas, al comenzar esta columna, acudo a muchos de mis escritores espirituales favoritos para ver qué opinan sobre las lecturas de esa semana. Pero esta semana, al orar sobre las Bienaventuranzas, un nombre surgió con fuerza: el Padre Greg Boyle, SJ, fundador de Homeboy Industries, el programa de intervención y rehabilitación de pandillas más grande del mundo (y sí, ahora también existe Homegirl Industries para las chicas).

Greg Boyle comprende a los pobres, a los débiles y a los que sufren. Emplea a cientos de ellos, algunos recién salidos de prisión, en sus panaderías y restaurantes de Los Ángeles. También comprende profundamente a quienes tienen hambre y sed de justicia. Él encabeza esa lista.

Su enseñanza sobre las Bienaventuranzas es sencilla. Es pura geografía. No se trata de QUÉ ser, sino de DÓNDE estar, que siempre será con los vulnerables. La verdadera bendición no es la salud ni la riqueza, sino encontrar vida y alegría en la solidaridad con quienes el mundo rechaza, incluso si eso lleva a la crucifixión, ya que ahí es donde está Jesús.

Así que, una reescritura de las Bienaventuranzas podría ser: «Sabes que estás en el lugar correcto si... eres sincero, trabajas por la justicia, muestras misericordia, trabajas por la paz».

Pero, ¿cómo podemos nosotros, que nunca hemos sido pobres materialmente, unirnos, como escribe Richard Rohr, a los pobres de espíritu, cuya «pobreza material ha quebrantado su espíritu»? Mi única respuesta es juntarme con personas que sirven a los pobres con abundante amor.

Cristo, que siempre estará del lado de los pobres, nos insta a acercarnos a los débiles del mundo para que también aprendamos de ellos. Porque de ellos es el reino.

¿Te has sentido alguna vez inspirado por alguien humilde y modesto?

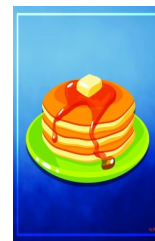

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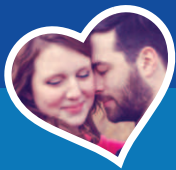
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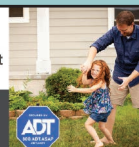


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
